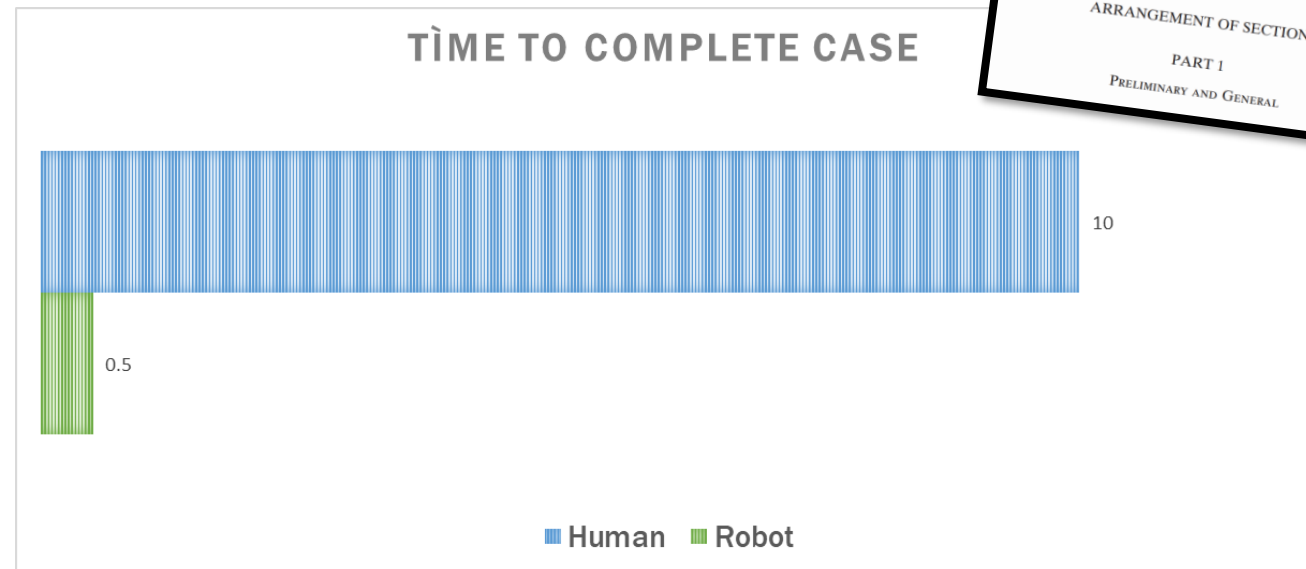
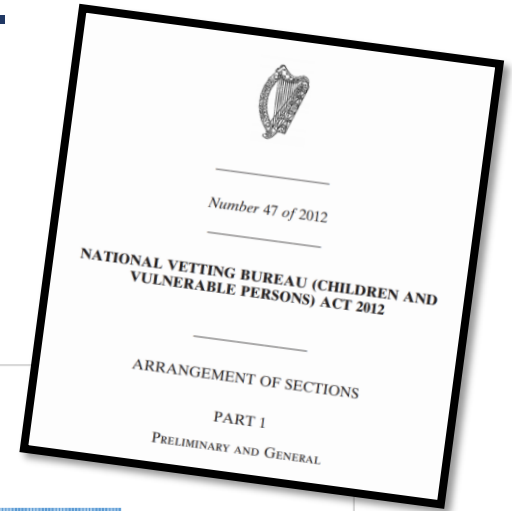


## Selection Rationale

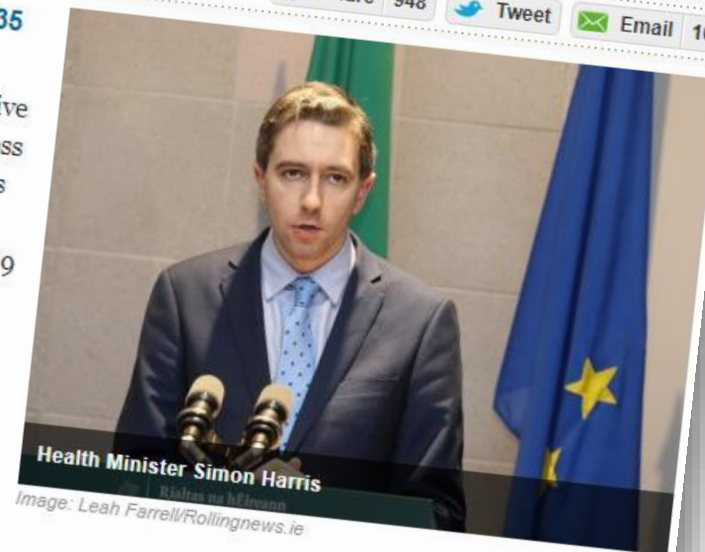

  - **Three environments**
  - **6 week build commenced mid-May & completed end June**
  - **Existing HBS processes in (full) Production. HPSC live by mid-August**
  - **On-premise for now but Cloud/Private Cloud needs consideration**
- ✓ Design infrastructural setup
  - ✓ Install application servers
  - ✓ Configure database
  - ✓ Establish database connection
  - ✓ Configure user permissions
  - ✓ Migrate processes to test
  - ✓ Test non-prod environment
  - ✓ Configure virtual machines
  - ✓ Configure robot domain accesses
  - ✓ On-board users on new environments
  - ✓ Migrate and test processes to production
  - ✓ Test production environment

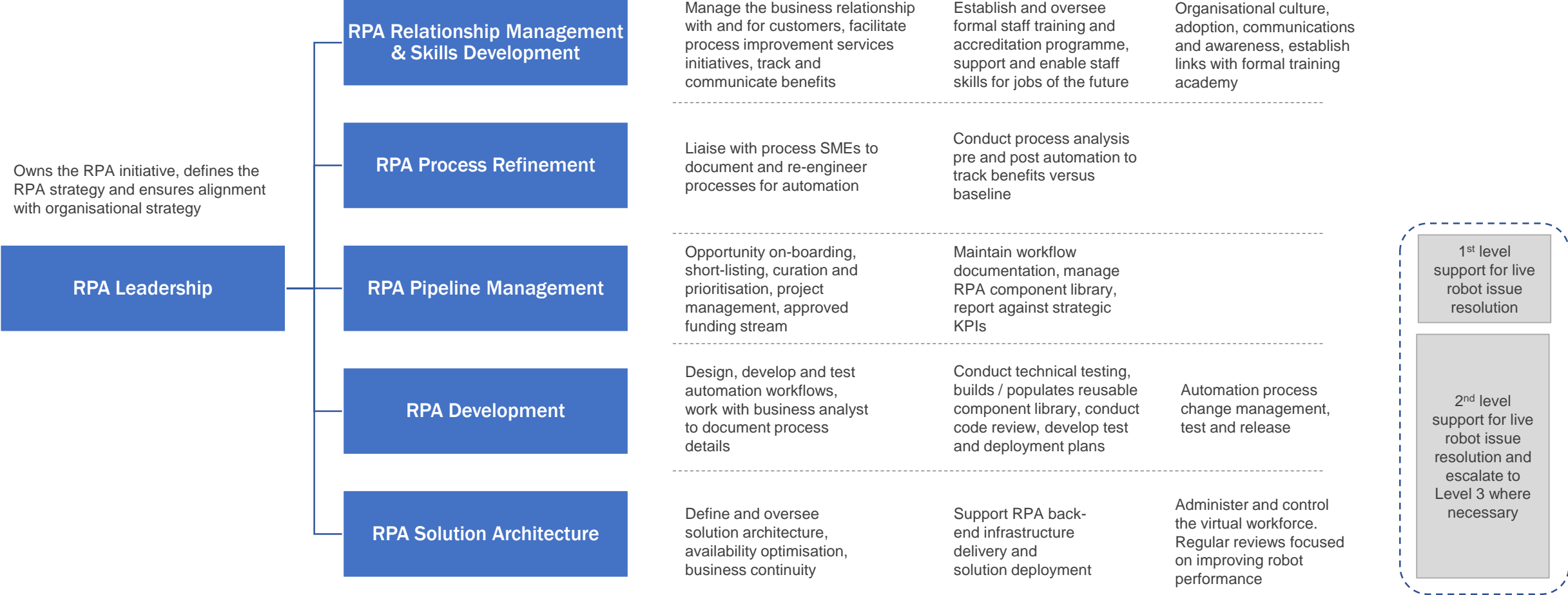




# Centre of Excellence - Design Considerations

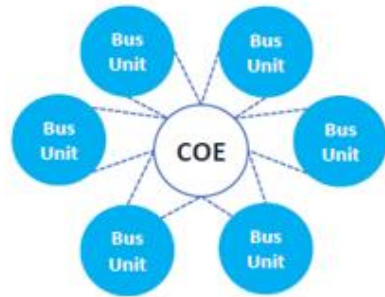
- HBS to deliver RPA CoE as a new Shared Service offering

# Centre of Excellence - Model?

## Centralised



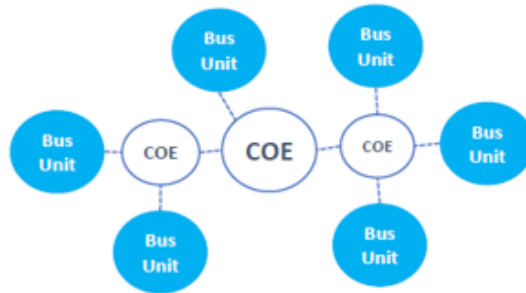
### Advantages:

- Ease of enterprise scale up
- Cost efficiencies through resource and infrastructure sharing
- Centralized ownership and governance
- Standardized processes and RPA solution
- Consistency of guidelines, training, etc.
- Centralized IT support

### Disadvantages:

- Automation prioritization challenges
- Difficulty to implement if centralized model not in place
- Unresponsiveness if not enough resources available

## Federated



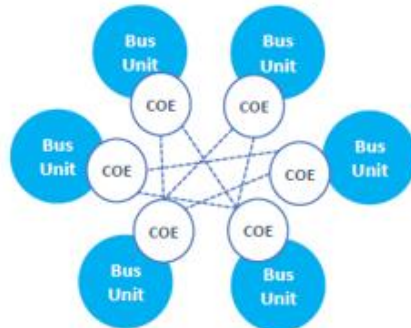
### Advantages:

- Main COE which defines RPA strategy and approach and has an information hub
- Additional regional / BU / function specific COEs doing RPA implementations
- Higher implementation speed
- Higher process knowledge specific to regions / Bus / Functions

### Disadvantages:

- Increased cost
- Potential discrepancy in implementation approach and knowledge
- Potential incoherence in process methodologies

## Decentralised



### Advantages:

- Function and / or BU ownership and automation prioritization
- Focus on function and / or BU specific benefits
- In-depth knowledge of Function / Business Unit

### Disadvantages:

- Difficulty scaling at the enterprise
- Higher investment due to duplication of resources and infrastructure
- Risk of inconsistency in RPA solutions

- Establish process selection criteria for RPA utilisation
- Approval of RPA application to a process

## RPA Projects RPA Operations

- Central advisory service for all local delivery hubs and one-off automation enquiries
- Customer engagement to assist with ideation and automation suitability
- Manage portal for opportunity on-boarding and documentation
- Liaise with OoCIO PMO for business case and funding approvals
- Solution recommendation
- Co-ordinate 3<sup>rd</sup> party developer activities
- RPA pipeline and project management

- Manage central HSE platform, availability optimisation and business continuity
- Robot supervision, robot performance management and activity reporting
- Code validation and change management
- Centralised licence management
- Manage shared component library
- Liaise with OoCIO Technology & Deployment for leading practice infrastructure delivery

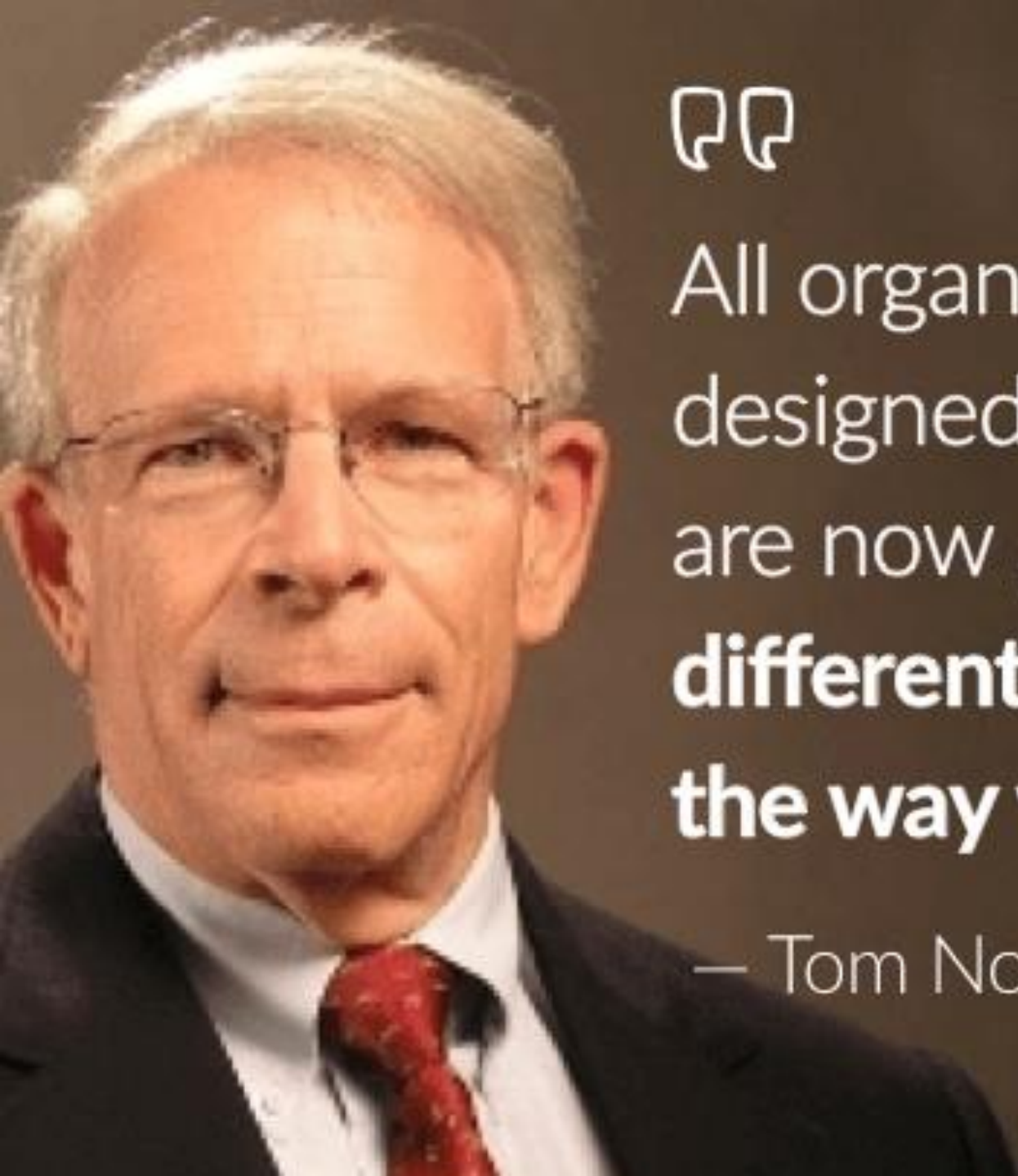
